A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N. 7°E., 75 lks.
dist., marked S 19 B T

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N. 5°W., 72 lks.
dist., marked S 24 B T

Asc. 334 ft. over broken SE. slope.

60.00 Enter old burn, bears E. and W., thence through
scattering timber and very dense undergrowth.

76.00 Ridge, bears NE. and SW., Grassy Ranch Trail and tele-
phone line along top of ridge, desc. 90 ft. over
NW. slope.

77.20 Leave old burn, bears NW. and SE., thence through
heavy timber and medium undergrowth.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 16 ins. in
