Land; mountainous.

Soil; mountain loam and rocky, 2nd and 4th rate.

Timber; fir, hemlock, yew, and pine.

Undergrowth; vinemaple, rhododendron, and arrow woos.

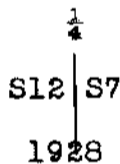
