A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S.42*W., 43 lks.

dist., marked T 25 S R 2 E S 12 B T

A hemlock, 10 ins. diam., bears N.60*W., 18 lks.

dist., marked T 25 S R 2 E S 1 B T

Land; mountainous.

Soil; rocky, 4th rate.

Timber; fir, hemlock, yew, pine, and cedar.

Undergrowth; vinemapple, rhododendron, and small fir.

North, bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Desc. 10 ft. over NW. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

2.10 Draw, course W., asc. 80 ft. over SW. slope.

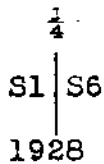
10.00 Spur, slopes W., desc. 56 ft. over NW. slope.
