dist., marked W C T 25 S R 2 E S 25 B T

A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears S.43\*E., 27 lks.

dist., marked W C T 25 S R 2 E S 36 B T

A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S.56\*W., 28 lks.

dist., marked W C T 25 S R 2 E S 35 B T

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N.48\*W., 28 lks.

dist., marked W C T 25 S R 2 E S 26 B T

80.00 Point for cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35, and 36, falls on face of low bluff, impracticable to set cor.

Land; mountainous.

Soil; mountain loam, 3rd rate.

Timber; fir, hemlock, pine, yew, and cedar.

Undergrowth; rhododendron, mountain laurel, arrow-wood, and vinemaple.

East, on a random line bet. secs. 25 and 36

40.00 Set temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.

80.08 Intersect E. bdy. of Tp. 14 lks. S. of the Cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31, and 36, hereinbefore described

Thence

S.89\*54'W., on true line bet. secs. 25 and 36

Asc. 248 ft. over E. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

9.50 Way trail, bears NW. and SE.

10.30 Ridge, bears NW. and SE., desc. 301 ft. over SW. slope.

24.00 Draw, course S., asc. 59 ft. over SE. slope.

28.50 Spur, slopes SW., desc. 370 ft. over W. slope.

37.20 Draw, course SW., asc. 25 ft. along steep S. slope.
