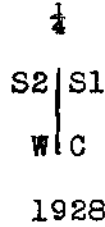


Subdivisions of T. 25 S., R. 2 E.

dist., marked W C $\frac{1}{4}$ S 1 B T

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N.59*W., 7 lks.
dist., marked W C $\frac{1}{4}$ S 2 B T

Asc. 22 ft. over N. slope.

- 65.40 Spur, slopes W., desc. 725 ft. over SW. slope.
- 92.00 Creek, 14 lks. wide, course W., asc. 235 ft. over NW. slope.
- 98.50 Spur, slopes W., along W. slope.
- 99.48 Cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11, and 12.
Land; mountainous.
Soil; rocky, 4th rate.
Timber; fir, hemlock, chinquapin, yew, and cedar.
Undergrowth; vinemaple, small fir, rhododendron, mountain laurel, chinquapin, and manzanita.

From the cor. of secs. 34 and 35 only, on S. bdy. of Tp. hereinbefore described.

N.0*02*W., bet. secs. 34 and 35

Asc. 543 ft. over SE. slope, over loose rock, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

- 15.30 Ridge, bears NE. and SW., asc. 290 ft. over SW. slope.
- 15.90 Grassy Ranch Trail, bears E. and W.
- 20.70 Grassy Ranch Trail, bears SE. and NW.
- 27.60 Way Trail, bears NW. and SE.
- 28.40 Spur, slopes W., desc. 332 ft. over NW. slope.
- 30.30 Grassy Ranch Trail, and telephone line, bears E. and W.
- 39.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in
