- 79.98 Cor. of secs. 26, 27, 34, and 35.
Land; mountainous.
Soil; rocky, mountain loam, 3rd rate.
Timber; fir, hemlock, yew, and cedar.
Undergrowth; rhododendron, mountain laurel, and vine maple.
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- N.0*02'W., bet secs. 26 and 27.
Asc. 50 ft. over SW. slope. through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
- 3.60 Spur ridge, bears NW. and SE., desc. 402 ft. over broken NE. slope.
- 9.20 Grassy Ranch Trail, and telephone line, bears NE. and SW.
- 30.50 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 25 ins. in the ground, for witness cor. to the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 26 and 27, with brass cap marked
