- 76.50 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course W.
- 80.00 Set an iron post, 3ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the cor. of secs. 22, 23, 26, and 27, with brass cap marked

Soil; rocky, 4th rate.

Timber; fir, hemlock, yew, and cedar.

Undergrowth; mountain laurel, rhododendron, and vinemaple.

- 40.00 S.89*56'E., on a random line bet. secs. 23 and 26 Set temp. 1/4 sec. cor.
- 79.72 Intersect N. and S. line, 34 lks. N. of the cor. of secs. 23, 24, 25, and 26, hereinbefore described. Thence N.89*41'W., on true line bet. secs. 23 and 26 Asc. 14 ft. over NE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
- 1.00 Spur, slopes NW., desc. 440 ft. over NW. slope.
- 7.00 Leave timber and undergrowth, bears NE. and SW., thence
