Land; mountainous.

Soil; rocky, mountain loam, 4th rate.

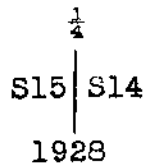
Timber; fir, hemlock, yew, and cedar.

Undergrowth; rhododendron and vinemaple.

N.0°02'W., bet. secs. 14 and 15

Along W. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

- 0.90 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course W., asc. 468 ft. over broken S., changing to SW. slope.
- 9.20 Spring, course SW.,
- 11.50 Draw, course S.10°W.,
- 32.20 Spur, slopes W., desc. 305 ft. over NW. slope.
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 14 and 15, with brass cap marked

A hemlock, 15 ins. diam., bears S.51°W., 43 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 15 B T

- 41.00 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course W., asc. 271 ft. over SW. slope.
- 60.10 Spur, slopes W., desc. 240 ft. over broken NW. slope to cor.
