44.00 Spur, slopes NE.

46.40 Spring, course NW.,

57.30 Draw, course E., along gradual E. slope.

65.80 S. edge of mucky flat, bears E. and W. drains E.,
thence across swamp.

71.30 N. Edge of swamp, bears E. and W.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 16 ins. in
the ground, to bed rock, and in mound of stone, 2 ft.
base, for the cor. of secs. 21, 22, 27, and 28, with
brass cap marked
