71.40 Spur, slopes NW., desc. 78 ft. over W. slope.

80.30 Cor. of secs. 15, 16, 21, and 22.

Land; mountainous.

Soil; mountain loam, 3rd rate.

Timber; fir, hemlock, cedar, and pine.

Undergrowth; rhododendron, vinemaple, and salal.

N.0°02'W., bet. secs. 15 and 16

Desc. 140 ft. over broken NW. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

17.60 Reynolds Creek, 18 lks. wide, course W., asc. 216 ft. over S. slope.

23.50 Spur, slopes, W., desc. 149 ft. over NW. slope.

27.20 Creek, 8 lks. wide, course SW., asc. 75 ft. over S. slope.

29.40 Spur, slopes, SW., desc. 20 ft. over NW. slope.

31.90 Creek, 4 lks. wide, course W., asc. 152 ft. over S. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 15 and 16, with brass cap marked

A cedar, 12 ins. diam., bears N.34°E., 25 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 15 B T

A cedar, 20 ins. diam., bears S.69°W., 22 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 16 B T

Along E. slope,

44.50 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course SE., asc. 312 ft. over SW., changing to S. slope.

64.10 Spur, slopes SE., asc. 124 ft. over broken SE. slope.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, for the cor. of secs. 9, 10, 15, and 16
