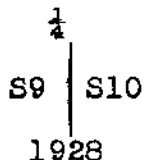


Subdivisions of T. 25 S., R. 2 E.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 9 and 10 with brass cap marked



from which,

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S.66*E., 27 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 10 B T

A cedar, 18 ins. diam., bears S.15*W., 38 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 9 B T

Desc. 30 ft. over NW. slope.

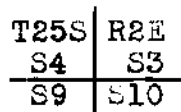
41.60 Draw, course NW., along W. slope.

51.30 Desc. 78 ft. over NE. slope.

53.70 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course NW., asc. 76 ft. over SW. slope.

66.00 Spur, slopes NW., desc. 362 ft. over N., changing to NW. slope.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for the cor. of secs. 3, 4, 9, and 10, with brass cap marked

A hemlock, 10 ins. diam., bears S.79*E., 54 lks. dist., marked T 25 S R 2 E S 10 B T

A hemlock, 5 ins. diam., bears S.58*W., 4 lks. dist., marked T 25 S R 2 E S 9 B T

A cedar, 6 ins. diam., bears N.8*W., 27 lks. dist., marked T 25 S R 2 E S 4 B T
