CHAINS

- 59.80 Spur, slopes N., desc. 200 ft. over NW. slope.
- 71.50 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course N., asc. 50 ft. over NE., slope.
- 80.08 Cor. of secs. 3, 4, 9, and 10.
Land; mountainous.
Soil; mountain loam, 4th rate.
Timber; hemlock, fir, cedar, and yew.
Undergrowth; rhododendron, vinemaple, and arrow-wood.

- 40.00 N.0*15'W., on a random line bet. secs. 3 and 4
Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
- 98.24 Intersect N. bdy. of Tp., 9 lks. E. of the cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33, and 34, as described in field notes of T. 24 S., R. 2 E.
Thence,
S.0*18'E., on true line bet. secs. 3 and 4
Asc. 27 ft. over NW. slope, through heavy timber and medium undergrowth.
- 1.30 Spur ridge, bears NE. and SW., trail along top of ridge desc. 220 ft. over broken SE. slope.
- 11.30 Draw, course E.,
- 17.20 Spur, slopes SE., trail along top of spur, desc. 390 ft. over broken SW. slope
- 36.70 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course SE., desc. 429 ft. over broken SE. slope.
- 33.10 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course SE.,
- 47.10 Trail bears E. and W.
- 51.60 Top of bluff, 70 ft. high, facing SE.
- 55.10 Big Bend Creek, 30 lks. wide, course SW., asc. 32 ft. over NW. slope.
- 58.24 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor. of secs. 3 and 4, with brass cap marked
