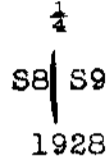


Subdivisions of T. 25 S., R. 2 E.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 8 and 9, with brass cap marked

A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S.67\*E., 28 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 9 B T

A cedar, 14 ins. diam., bears S.55\*W., 36 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 8 B T

Along gradual W. slope

49.80 Spur, slopes W., desc. 463 ft. over broken NW. slope. to cor.

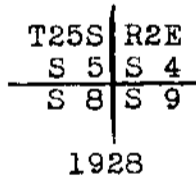
60.20 Draw, course NW.,

63.30 Spur, slopes NW.,

A hemlock, 6 ins. diam., bears S.66\*E., 37 lks. dist., marked T 25 S R 2 E S 9 B T

A fir, 5 ins. diam., bears S.51\*W., 35 lks. Dist., marked T 25 S R 2 E S 8 B T

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N.59\*W., 55 lks. dist., marked T 25 S R 2 E S 5 B T
