- Thence
- N.89°57'W., on true line. bet. secs. 29 and 32.
- Along broken S. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
- 1.70 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course S.
- 7.90 Spur, slopes S.
- 9.00 Draw, spring, course S., asc. 190 ft. over broken SE. slope.
