- 57.00 Spur, slopes S.,
- 72.70 Creek bed, dry, 2 lks. wide, course SE.,
- 74.70 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course SE.,
- 80.02 Cor. of Secs. 29, 30, 31, and 32.
 Land; mountainous.
 Soil; mountain loam, 4th rate.
 Timber; fir, hemlock, cedar, yew, and pine.
 Undergrowth; rhododendron, vinemaple, and salal.

- West on a random line bet. secs. 30 and 31.
- 40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
- 59.69 Intersect W. bdy. of Tp. 33 lks. N. of the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31, and 36, described in field notes of T. 25 S., R 1 E.
 Thence,
 N.89*41'E., on true line, bet. secs. 30 and 31.
 Asc. 175 ft. over NW. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
