over broken SW. slope, to cor.

38.50 Spur, slopes S.,

40.00 Draw, course S.,

46.30 Spur, slopes S.,

59.69 Cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31, and 32.

Land; mountainous.

Soil; rocky, 4th rate.

Timber; fir, hemlock, cedar, and pine.

Undergrowth; rhododendron, vinemaple, hazel, huckle-
berry, and arrow-wood.
