dist., marked T 25 S R 2 E S 18 B T

Land; mountainous.

Soil; rocky mountain loam, 4th rate.

Timber; fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, yew, and chinquapin.

Undergrowth; rhododendron, vinemaple, salal, huckleberry, and chinquapin.

S.89*54'E., on a random line bet. secs. 17 and 20.

40.00 Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

79.96 Intersect N. and S. line 5 lks. S. of cor. of secs. 16, 17, 20, and 21, hereinbefore described

Thence

N.89*56'W., on true line bet. secs. 17 and 20

Over nearly level land, through heavy timber and medium undergrowth.

6.20 Spur, slopes N., desc. 192 ft. over broken NW. slope.

19.20 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course NE.

24.10 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course NE., asc. 95 ft. over NE. slope.

31.40 Way trail bears NW. and SW.

32.50 Ridge, bears N. and S., desc. 90 ft. over NW. slope.
