- 53.30 Steamboat Trail, and telephone line, bears NE. and SW.
- 64.70 Spur, slopes E., desc. 70 ft. over NE. slope.
- 68.20 Draw, course SE., asc. 226 ft. over S., changing to SE. slope.
- 80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 25 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7, and 8, with brass cap marked

Timber; fir, cedar, hemlock, yew, and pine.

Undergrowth; salal, vinemaple, rhododendron, arrow-wood, huckle berry, and mountain laurel.
