- 4.50 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course NW.,
- 17.40 Big Bend Trail, bears NE. and SW.,
- 24.80 Big Bend Creek, 60 lks. wide, course W., from NE.,  
thence down creek.
- 30.40 Leave creek, course SW., from E., along gradual S. slope
- 39.90 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in  
the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 5 and 8, with  
brass cap marked

- 52.40 Big Bend Trail, bears NW. and SE.
- 56.00 Big Bend Creek, 60 lks. wide, course N.80\*W.,
- 58.00 Steamboat Creek, 90 lks. wide, course SW., asc. 490 ft.  
over broken SE. slope to cor.
- 60.30 Steamboat Trail, and telephone line, bears NE. and SW.
- 76.10 Spur, slopes SE.,
- 78.10 Draw, course SW.,
- 79.80 Cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7, and 8.

Land; mountainous.

Soil; rocky mountain loam, 3rd rate.

Undergrowth; vinemaple, salal, rhododendron, salmon  
berry, and arrow-wood.

Timber; fir, hemlock, yew, cedar, and alder.
