- 59.11 Intersect W. bdy. of Tp. 26 lks. N. of cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7, and 12, described in field notes of T. 25 S., R. 1 E.
- Thence
- N.89°41'E., on true line bet. secs. 6 and 7
- Desc. 170 ft. over NE. slope, through old burn, dense undergrowth.
- 4.10 Johnson Creek, 4 lks. wide, course S., asc. 247 ft. over broken SW. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
- 5.70 Spur, slopes SW.,
- 6.50 Draw, course SW.,
- 19.11 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 7, with brass cap marked

- 32.70 Spur, slopes SE., desc. 170 ft. over SE. slope
- 42.90 Draw, course SW., asc. 80 ft. over SW. slope.
- 46.00 Spur, slopes S., desc. 176 ft. over SE. slope.
- 51.80 Spur, slopes SE., desc. 245 ft. over NE. slope.
- 56.30 Draw, course SE., desc. 30 ft. over SE. slope.
- 59.11 Cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7, and 8.
- Land; mountainous.
- Soil; rocky mountain loam 4th rate.
