69.60 Draw, drains S.,

74.32 The cor. of Tps. 25 S., Rs. 2 and 3 E.,

Land; mountainous

Soil; rocky, 4th rate.

Timber; fir, pine, hemlock, madrona, and yew.

Undergrowth; rhododendron, vinemaple, hazel, dogwood,  
and manzanita.

East Boundary of T. 25 S.; R. 3 E.

From the cor. of Tps. 24 and 25 S., R. 3 E.,

which is an iron post, 3 ins. diam., 8 ins. above  
ground, firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described  
in the official record.South on a random line, for distance only, on the E.  
boundary of T. 25 S., R. 3 E., setting regular temp.  
 $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. and sec. cors.; at 505.78 chs., intersect  
line projected east from the cor. of Tps.  
25 S., Rs. 2 and 3 E., at point of intersection
