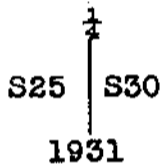
Desc. 20 ft. over NW. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth

2.60 Creek, 6 lks. wide, course SW., Asc. 280 ft. over SE. slope.

15.20 Spur, slopes SE., along broken E. slope.

22.00 Same creek, 5 lks. wide, course SE., asc. 643 ft. over SW. slope

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in. the ground, for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. with brass cap mkd.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for the cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25, and 30, with brass cap mkd.
