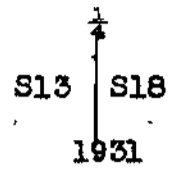

A fir, 38 ins. diam., bears N.88°W., 84 lks. dist., mkd. ¼ S 13 B T

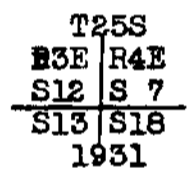
Along broken E. slope.

48.00 Desc. 400 ft. over broken NE. slope.

64.30 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course E., along broken E. slope.

79.40 Draw, drains E.,

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground to bedrock, and in a mound of stone to top, for cor. of secs. 7, 12, 13, and 18, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 42 ins. diam., bears N.58°E., 56 lks. dist., mkd. T 25 S R 4 E S 7 B T

A fir, 34 ins. diam., bears S.26°E., 42 lks. dist., mkd. T 25 S R 4 E S 18 B T

A fir, 38 ins. diam., bears S.74°W., 70 lks. dist., mkd. T 25 S R 3 E S 13 B T

A fir, 50 ins. diam., bears N.67°W., 70 lks. dist., mkd. T 25 S R 3 E S 12 B T

Land; mountainous.

Soil; rocky, 4th rate.

Timber; fir, hemlock, pine, cedar, and yew.

Undergrowth; rhododendron, vinemaple, manzanita, and huckleberry.
