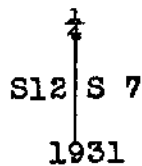

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. with brass cap mkd.
