CHAINS

39.80 The cor. of secs. 34 and 35 only, which is an iron post, 2 ins. diam., 8 ins. above ground, firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record.

Land; mountainous.

Soil; rocky, 4th rate.

Timber; fir, pine, hemlock, and cedar.

Undergrowth; vinemaple, rhododendron, hazel, willow, and alder.

S.89°56'W., on true line bet. secs. 2 and 34

Desc. 47 ft. over W. slope, through heavy timber and medium undergrowth.

1.90 Bottom of depression, no apparent outlet, asc. 37 ft. over NE. slope.

2.04 Point for closing cor. of secs. 2 and 3, as hereinafter determined.

Thence, bet. secs. 3 and 34, continue line and measurement

Asc. 797 ft. over broken NE. slope, over bluffs.

40.20 The  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 34 only, which is an iron post, 1 in. diam., 8 ins. above ground, firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record.

N.89°57'W., on true line bet. secs. 3 and 34

Asc. 38 ft. over E. slope.

1.70 Mid point bet. closing cors., as hereinafter determined set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 3 only, with brass cap mkd.
