Undergrowth; vinemapple, rhododendron, mountain laurel,
hazel.

14.50 Spur, slopes SE., desc. 30 ft. along E. slope.

20.00 Draw, course SE., asc. 76 ft. over S. slope.

25.40 Desc. 29 ft. over NW. slope.

29.00 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course SE., from W., enter
Willow marsh, along creek 2 lks. wide, from N.

40.00 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. falls in creek

40.40 Leave marsh, course of creek, S. from N.10°E., enter
heavy timber and medium undergrowth, bears W. and SE
