A fir, 38 ins. diam., bears S.17°E., 33 lks. dist., mkd. T 25 S R 3 E S 2 C C B T

A fir, 32 ins. diam., bears S.41°W., 53 lks. dist., mkd. T 25 S R 3 E S 3 C C B T

From this point the cor. of secs. 34 and 35

T. 24 S., R. 3 E., bears N.89°56'E., 204 lks. dist.

Land; mountainous.

Soil; rocky, 4th rate.

Timber; fir, hemlock, cedar, and pine.

Undergrowth; rhododendron, vinemaple, alder, and chinquapin.

Thence, from the cor. of secs. 33 and 34, only, on the S. bdy. of Tp.

N.0°02'W., bet. secs. 33 and 34

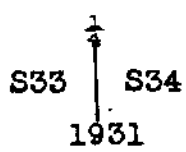
Desc. 150 ft. over NE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth

6.00 Creek, 3 lks. wide, course N.75°W., asc. 202 ft. over SW. slope.

18.50 Spur, slopes SW., desc. 113 ft. over NW. slope.

24.10 Draw, course S.75°W., asc. 562 ft. over S. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for the 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S.53°E., 8 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S 34 B T

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S.57°W., 32 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S 33 B T

Asc. 342 ft. over SW. slope.

54.30 Spur, slopes S.80°W., desc. 414 ft. over NW. slope.

73.50 Draw, course N.75°W., asc. 131 ft. over SW. slope.
