80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for the cor. of secs. 27, 28, 33, and 34 with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S.42°W., 74 lks dist., mkd. T 25 S R 3 E S 33 B T

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N.25°W., 56 lks. dist., mkd. T 25 S R 3 E S 28 B T

Land; mountainous.

Soil; rocky, 4th rate.

Timber; fir, cedar, hemlock, pine, madrona, and yew.

Undergrowth; vinemaple, rhododendron, manzanita, mountain laurel, chinquapin, dogwood, and huckleberry

East on random line bet. secs. 27 and 34

40.00 Set temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.

79.90 Intersect N. and S. line, 14 lks. N. of the cor. of secs. 26, 27, 34, and 35

Thence

N.89°54'W., on true line bet. secs. 27 and 34

Desc. 818 ft. over broken NW. slope, to the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. through old burn, scattered timber and dense undergrowth.

9.00 Leave burn, enter heavy timber and medium undergrowth bears N. and S.

12.50 Enter meadow, bears N. and S.,

21.10 Mountain Meadow Trail, bears N. and S.
