- 40.00 West on a random line bet. secs. 30 and 31
Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
- 74.18 Intersect W. bdy. of Tp., 29 lks. N. of the cor. of
secs. 25, 30, 31, and 36, which is an iron post,
2 ins. diam., 12 ins. above ground, firmly set,
marked and witnessed as described in the official
record.
- Thence
N.89°47'E., on true line bet. secs. 30 and 31
Desc. 150 ft. over SE. slope, through heavy timber
and medium undergrowth.
