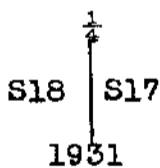
CHAINS

- 60.60 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course S.15°E., asc. 218 ft. over SW., changing to S. slope.
- 71.30 Draw, course SW., asc. 141 ft. over NW. slope.
- 73.88 Cor. of secs. 17, 18, 19, and 20.
Land; mountainous.
Soil; rocky, 4th rate.
Timber; fir, hemlock, pine, and cedar.
Undergrowth; alder, vinemaple, manzanita, chinquapin, mountain laurel, rhododendron, and huckleberry.

N.0°04'W., bet. secs. 17 and 18

Along W. slope, through heavy timber, and medium undergrowth.

- 1.90 Draw, course SW., asc. 627 ft. over broken SW. slope.
- 9.80 Spur, slopes SW.,
- 13.00 Draw, course SW.,
- 29.70 Ridge, bears N.60°W., and S.60°E., Grassy Ranch Trail, and Forest Service telephone line, along top of ridge, desc. 344 ft. over N., changing to NE. slope.
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.48°E., 48 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 17 B T

A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.78°W., 27 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 18 B T

Desc. 91 ft. over N. slope.

- 46.90 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course NW., asc. 131 ft. over S. slope.
- 61.80 Low spur, ridge, bears E. and W., desc. 96 ft. over gradual N. slope.
