

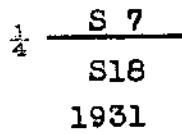

22.60 Rocky spur, slopes N.15°E., desc. 46 ft. over gradual NE. slope.

33.59 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 22 ins. diam., bears S.67°E., 167 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S 18 B T

A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N.38°W., 134 lks. dist., mkd. 1/4 S 7 B T

Desc. 48 ft. over gradual NE. slope.

48.10 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course N., asc. 90 ft. over gradual NW. slope.

54.00 Creek, 6 lks. wide, course NW.,

57.70 Same creek, course S.75°W.,

61.10 Same creek, course N.70°W., asc. 368 ft. over W. slope

73.59 Cor. of secs. 7, 8, 17, and 18

Land; mountainous.

Soil; rocky, 4th rate.

Timber; fir, hemlock, pine, cedar, and yew.

Undergrowth; alder, vinemapple, young fir, elderberry and cascara.

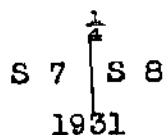
N.0°04'W., bet. secs. 7 and 8

Asc. 390 ft. over SW. slope, through heavy timber and medium undergrowth.

16.50 Spur, slopes NW., desc. 289 ft. over N. slope.

27.90 Desc. 55 ft. over gradual NW., changing to W. slope.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
