A Fir, 48 ins. diam., bears S.70*E., 21 lks.
dist. marked T 25 S R 5 E S 3 B T.

A Fir, 54 ins. diam., bears S.50*W., 16 lks.
dist. marked T 25 S R 5 E S 4 B T.

A Larch, 20 ins. diam; bears N.25*W., 13 lks.
dist. marked T 24 S R 5 E S 33 B T.

Land; mountainous.

Soil; rocky 4th rate.

Timber; Fir, Hemlock and Larch.

Undergrowth; Hemlock and Fir.

Mountainous land heavily timbered or covered with dense undergrowth 80.00 chains.

East bet. secs. 3 and 34, over mountainous land heavily timbered and covered with dense undergrowth.

9.00 Brook 10 lks. wide, course N. 30 E Foot of descent.
