CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

This Tp. containing all of sec. 1 and part. of secs. 2 and 3 is mountainous and broken with an unfertile soil 4th rate.

Dense Forest, of Fir, Pine, Hemlock and Larch timber prevail everywhere and render the Township chiefly valuable for lumbering.

The Middle Fork of the Willamette River runs through secs. 1 and 2 of the Tp. and renders water abundant.

There is quite an extensive beaver marsh in secs. 1 and 2 apparently inhabited by hundreds of beavers whose dams obstruct the river.
