A pine, 14 ins. in dia., bears S.70*W. 26 lks. dist., marked T 25 S R 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ E S 3 B T.

A hemlock, 12 ins. in dia., bears N.35*W. 8 lks. dist., marked T 24 S R 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ E S 34 B T.
