

East boundary of T 25 S., R. 5 1/2 E.

CHAINS

Undergrowth hemlock and larch.  
Mountainous land heavily timbered or covered with dense undergrowth. 60.00 chains Sept. 19th 1902.

General Description

This Township lies on the summit of the Cascade mountains, hence the surface is broken and mountainous.  
The Township is well watered by numerous ponds and lakes.  
The soil is of volcanic origin.  
The Township is well timbered.

Subdivisions of T 25 S. R. 5 1/2 E.  
Same Deputy and Contract.

The corner of sections 1, 2, 35 and 36 T 25 S R 5 1/2 E. being in an impassable lake, I proceed to offset as follows:

From the Witness cor. on N. bdy. of Tp. at W. edge of lake, which I previously established, and which is 50 lks. W. of sec. cor. I run W. 3.00 chs. Thence S. 0\*1'E. on offset line 7.20 chs. Thence, E. 3.50 chs. to true line whereat,

7.20 I mark a hemlock, 24 in dia., for Witness cor. to secs. 1 and 2 marked W C T 24 S R 5 1/2 E S 36 on NE. T 25 S S 2 on SW. and S 35 on NW. sides, with 1 notch on E and 5 on W edges, from which,

A hemlock, 30 ins. in dia., bears N.40\*E. 23 lks. dist., marked W C T 25 S R 5 1/2 E S 1 B T.

A hemlock, 8 ins. in dia., bears S.80\*W. 35 lks. dist., marked W C T 25 S R 5 1/2 E S 2 B T.

Thence I run S.0\*1'E. bet. secs. 1 and 2, over mountainous land heavily timbered and covered with dense undergrowth.  
Ascending gently from the cor.

27.50 Lake of about 1 1/2 acres, bears W. 30 lks. dist.,

40.00 Set a hemlock post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq. 2 ft. in ground, for 1/4 sec. cor. marked 1/4 S 2 on W and 1 on E face, from which,  
A hemlock, 10 ins. in dia., bears S.55\*E. 14 lks. dist., marked 1/4 S 1 B T.
