40.00	<p>A hemlock, 48 ins. in dia., bears W. 22 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 11 B T.</p> <p>Land mountainous heavily timbered and covered with dense undergrowth.</p> <p>Soil, volcanic ashes, 4th rate.</p> <p>Timber hemlock and fir.</p> <p>Undergrowth hemlock and fir.</p> <p>Mountainous or heavily timbered land. 40.00 chains.</p>
	<p>East on a random bet. secs. 1 and 12</p>
40.00	<p>Set temp. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.</p>
80.00	<p>Intersect E. bdy. of Tp. 24 lks. S of cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12. Thence I run S. 89° 50' W. on a true line, bet. secs 1 and 12.</p> <p>Over mountainous land, heavily timbered and with dense undergrowth. Ascending from cor.</p>
39.90	<p>Intersect N. end of shallow lake of about 5 acres (15 ins. deep).</p>
40.00	<p>Set a hemlock post, 3 ft. long, 4 ins. sq. 3 ft. in ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 1 on N. and 12 on S faces from which,</p> <p>A hemlock, 16 ins. in dia., bears N. 35° E. 14 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 1 B T.</p> <p>A hemlock, 12 ins. in dia., bears S. 50° W. 9 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 12 B T.</p>

78.00	<p>Summit of ridge, bears N. and S. desc.</p>
80.00	<p>Cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12.</p> <p>Land mountainous heavily timbered and covered with dense undergrowth.</p> <p>Soil, volcanic ashes, 4th rate.</p> <p>Timber hemlock and fir.</p>
