

## Resurvey of South Bdy. of Tp. 25 S., R. 2 E.

## CHAINS

- West on true line on S. bdy. of sec. 36.
- 39.83 Point for closing cor. of Tps. 25 $\frac{1}{2}$  S., Rs. 2 and 3 E., as later determined and hereinafter described.
- 40.00 The  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 36 only, which is an iron post, 1 in. diam., 9 ins. above ground, marked and witnessed as described in the field notes of Tp. 25 S., R 2 E., this Group.
- 79.85 Point for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 36 only, Tp. 25 $\frac{1}{2}$  S., R 2 E., later determined.
- Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 36 only, with brass cap marked

- A Fir, 6 ins. diam., bears S.18\*E., 70 lks. dist., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 36 B T.
- A Cedar, 36 ins. diam., bears S.27\*W., 65 lks. dist. marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 36 B T.
- 80.10 <sup>of</sup> Cor. secs. 35 and 36 only, which is an iron post, 2 ins. diam., 9 ins. above ground, marked and witnessed as described in the field notes of Tp. 25 S., R. 2 E., this Group.

- West, on true line on S. bdy. of sec. 35.
- 39.77 Point for closing cor. of secs. 35 and 36, Tp. 25 $\frac{1}{2}$  S., R. 2 E., later determined and hereinafter described.
- 40.07 The  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 35 only, which is an iron post, 1 in. diam., 8 ins. above ground, marked and witnessed as described in the field notes of Tp. 25 S., R. 2 E.,
