40.15 Point for closing cor. of secs. 32 and 33, Tp. 25 $\frac{1}{2}$ S., R. 2 E., later determined and hereinafter described.

40.20 The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 32 only, which is an iron post, 1 in. diam., 12 ins. above ground, marked and witnessed as described in the field notes of Tp. 25 S., R. 2 E., this Group.

80.10 Cor. of secs. 31 and 32 only, which is an iron post, 2 ins. diam., 13 ins. above ground, marked and witnessed as described in the field notes of Tp. 25 S., R. 2 E., this Group.

0.075 Point for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 32 only, Tp. 25 $\frac{1}{2}$ S., R. 2 E., later determined.
