Subdivisions of Tp. 25½ S., R. 2 E.

CHAINS

From the cor. of secs. 1, 2, ³⁵25, and 36 on S. bdy. of Tp., as described in the field notes of T. 26 S., R. 2 E.

N.0°01'W., bet. secs. 35 and 36

Asc. 280 ft. over SE. slope, through medium timber and dense undergrowth.

6.60 Spur, slopes S.10°W., asc. 200 ft. over SW. slope.

15.10 Ridge, bears NW. and SE., trail along top, desc. 410 ft. over NE. slope.

35.60 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course SE.

35.64 Intersect S. bdy. of T. 25 S., R. 2 E., 30 lks. E of the ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 35 only, hereinbefore described
At point of intersection set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, for closing cor. of secs. 35 and 36, with brass cap marked

Timber; Fir, Cedar, Pine, Yew, Hemlock, Oregon Maple, and Madrona.

Undergrowth; Wild Cherry, Rhododendron, Mountain Laurel, Chinquapin, Hazel, Manzanita, Arrow-wood and Huckleberry.
