

Subdivisions of Tp. 25 $\frac{1}{2}$ S., R 2 E.

CHAINS

From the cor. of Secs. 2, 3, 34, and 35, on S. bdy. of Tp., as described in the field notes of T.26 S., R. 2 E.

N.0*02'W. bet. secs. 34 and 35

Asc. 1290 ft. over broken SE. slope, through heavy timber and medium undergrowth.

6.00 Draw, course SE.

22.50 Grassy Ranch Trail and telephone line, bears N.70*E. and S.70*W.

28.50 Bluff 150 ft. high, bears E. and W.

29.00 Top of asc., bears E. and W., thence across nearly level top of ridge.

32.00 Ridge bears N.70*E. and S.70*W.

34.50 Desc. 60 ft. over N. slope.

35.11 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 5 ins. in the ground, and supported by mound of stone, 5 ft. base, for witness cor. to closing cor. of secs. 34 and 35, with brass cap marked

A Fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.81*E., 75 lks.,
dist. marked W C T 25 $\frac{1}{2}$ S R 2 E S 35 C C B T

A Fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S.50*W., 33 lks.
dist. marked W C T 25 $\frac{1}{2}$ S R 2 E S 34 C C B T

Desc. 120 ft. over bluff facing N.

35.50 Intersect S.bdy of T. 25 S., R. 2 E., 16 lks. W. of true point for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 34 only, as hereinbefore described; impracticable to set closing cor. on face of bluff.

Land; rough mountainous.
Soil; rocky, 4th rate.
