N.0°03'W., bet. secs. 32 and 33

Desc. 437 ft. over NE. slope, heavy timber and medium undergrowth.

18.40 Spur, slopes NW., desc. 309 ft. over N. slope,

27.90 Creek, 20 lks. wide, course N.70°W., asc. 277 ft. over S. slope.

29.00 Way trail, bears E. and W.,

35.78 Intersect S. bdy. of sec. 32 T 25 S R 3 E., 5.00 chs.

E. of the 1/4 sec. cor. of sec. 32 only

At point of intersection set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 6 ins. in the ground to bedrock, and in a mound of stone, 5 ft. base, to the top, with brass cap mkd.
