45.50 Divide, bet. North Umpqua River and Steamboat Creek,
bears SE. and NW.

Descend 247 ft. over SW. slope.

54.70 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course SE.

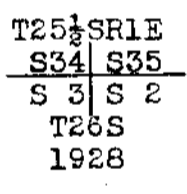
Ascend 155 ft. over SE. slope.

63.80 Spur, slopes S.

Descend 303 ft. over broken SW. slope.
