

Survey of the N. Bdy. of T. 26 S., R. 1 E.

CHAINS

West, bet. secs. 3 and 34.

Ascend 10' ft. over SE. slope, through timber and brush.

1.00 Spur, slopes SE.

11.00 A boulder, 60x15x30 ft. above ground, 2 lks. N. of line.

14.90 Spur, slopes S.

Descend 717 ft. over broken W. slope.

20.90 A boulder, (Red Man's Tooth), 30x30x100 ft. above ground, on line.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked,

$$\begin{array}{r} S34 \\ \frac{1}{4} \\ \hline S 3 \end{array}$$

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N.3*E., 35 lks. dist.

Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 34 B T.

A fir, 7 ins. diam., bears S.60*E., 7 lks. dist.

Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 3 B T.

Descend 360 ft. over broken SW. slope.

43.60 Top of bluff, 20 ft. high, bears N. and S., faces W.

49.60 Draw, course SW.

59.90 Draw, course S.

Ascend 124 ft. over SE. slope.

71.70 Spur, slopes S.

Descend 61 ft. over SW. slope.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the cor., of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34, with brass cap, marked
