

Survey of the N. Bdy. of T. 26 S., R. 1 E.

CHAINS

N.73°35'W., 6.08 chs.

S.81°W., 8.77 chs.

S.80°W., 2.00 chs. to a point on line, 16.46 chs. W. of the starting point for traverse.

73.23 Intersect the Willamette meridian, 47.75 chs. N.0°04'E., of the 1/4 sec. cor. of sec. 1 only, as hereinbefore described.

At point of intersection;

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. in diam., 16 ins. in the ground to bedrock, supported in a mound of stone, with a 4 ft. base, 1 ft. high, for the closing Tp. cor. of Tps. 25 1/2 and 26 S., R. 1 E., with brass cap marked,

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N.17°E., 62 lks. dist.

Marked T 25 1/2 S R 1 E S 31 C C B T.

An oak, 4 ins. diam., bears S.89°E., 41 lks. dist.

Marked T 26 S R 1 E S 6 C C B T.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky, and loam, third rate.

Timber, fir and hemlock.

Undergrowth, vine maple, grease wood, salal, rhododendron and dog wood.

Subdivisions, T. 26 S., R. 1 E.

From the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36 on the S. bdy. of the Tp., as described in the notes of T. 27 S., R. 1 E.
