Descend 198 ft. over NE. slope.

6.60 Calf Creek Way Trail, bears NE. and SW.

15.60 Divide, bet. Calf Creek and Limpy Creek, bears NE. and SW.

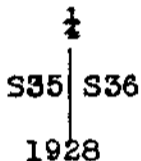
Descend 700 ft. over broken NW. slope.

20.70 Draw, course NW.

33.28 Rock point, 20 ft. high, faces NW. and SW.

37.50 Draw, course NW.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the 1/4 sec. cor. with brass cap marked,

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N.43\*E., 23 lks. dist.

Marked 1/4 S 36 B T.

A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N.60\*W., 36 lks. dist.

Marked 1/4 S 35 B T.

Descend 80 ft. over NW. slope.

42.70 Dry creek bed, 2 lks. wide, course N.60\*W.

Ascend 145 ft. over SW. slope.

48.20 Small spur, slopes S.75\*W.

Descend 325 ft. over NW. slope.

56.50 Dry Creek bed, 2 lks. wide, course S.75\*W.

Ascend 537 ft. over SW. slope.

69.70 Spur, slopes W.

Descend 438 ft. over NW. slope.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36, with brass cap marked,
