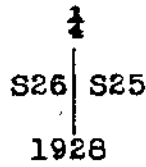


Subdivisions, T. 26 S., R. 1 E:

CHAINS



from which

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.37*E., 16 lks. dist.

Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 25 B T.

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.55*W., 13 lks. dist.

Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 26 B T.

Descend 300 ft. over NW. slope.

46.10 Dry creek bed, 3 lks. wide, course NW.

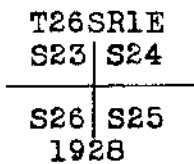
Ascend 630 ft. over broken SW. slope.

55.30 Draw, course SW.

72.70 Spur, slopes W.

Descend 170 ft. over NW. slope.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the cor. of secs. 23, 24, 25 and 26, with brass cap marked,



from which

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N.25*E., 62 lks. dist.

Marked T 26 S R 1 E S 24 B T.

A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S.73*E., 50 lks. dist.

Marked T 26 S R 1 E S 25 B T.

A pine, 12 ins. diam., bears S.19*W., 30 lks. dist.

Marked T 26 S R 1 E S 26 B T.

A maple, 10 ins. diam., bears N.22*W., 39 lks. dist.

Marked T 26 S R 1 E S 23 B T.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky loam, third rate.

Timber, fir, madrone, pine and maple.

Undergrowth, vine maple and rhododendron.
