N.0*01'E., bet. sec. 23 and 24.

Over mountainous land, through timber and brush.

Ascend 98 ft. over SW. slope.

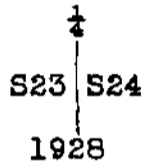
6.00 Glen Echo branch of Calf Creek Way Trail, bears SE. and NW.

6.40 Spur, slopes NW.

Descend 870 ft. over broken NW. slope.

22.30 Draw, course N.30*W.

40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked,



from which

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N.41*E., 12 lks. dist.

Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 24 B T.

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S.76*W., 50 lks. dist.

Marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 23 B T.

41.00 Draw, course NW.

Ascend 70 ft. over SW. slope.

49.40 Spur, slopes NW.

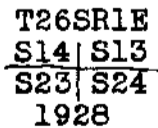
Descend 960 ft. over broken N. slope.

72.70 North Umpqua River, 180 lks. wide, course N.70*W.

Ascend 107 ft. over S. slope.

74.00 North Umpqua River Trail and telephone line, bears SE. and NW.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 13, 14, 23 and 24, with brass cap marked,



from which

A fir, 32 ins. diam., bears N.50*E., 78 lks. dist.

Marked T 26 S R 1 E S 13 B T.

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.21*E., 104 lks. dist.
