CHAINS

- 65.60 Draw, course S.
Ascend 60 ft. over gradual broken SE. slope.
- 79.78 The cor. of secs. 13, 14, 23 and 24.
Land, mountainous.
Soil, rocky loam, third rate.
Timber, fir, pine and madrone.
Undergrowth, vine maple and rhododendron.

- N.0°01'W., bet. secs. 13 and 14.
Ascend 1261 ft. over broken S. slope, through timber and brush.
- .60 Old River Trail, (no longer in use) and telephone line bears S.60°E., and N.60°W.
- 14.10 Top of bluff, 60 ft. high, bears N.80°E. and S.80°W., faces S.10°E.
- 17.60 Tent over mine shaft, bears N.57°E.
- 32;50 Tent over mine shaft, bears N.66°30'E., and from mine shaft a cabin bears approximately N.30°E., about 5 chs. dist.
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap marked,

Ascend 1140 ft. over broken S. slope.
- 43.70 Spur, slopes S.20°W.
- 64.30 Draw, course S.30°W.
- 74.51 Jackass Mt. Trail, bears S.75°E., and N.75°W.
- 80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. in diam., 27 ins. in
