 69.70 Spur, slopes NW.

 80.20 The cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12.
 Land, mountainous.
 Soil, rocky loam, third rate.
 Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar and yew.
 Undergrowth, vine maple and rhododendron.

From the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34, and 35 on the S. bdy. of
 the Tp., as described in the notes of T. 27 S., R. 1 E.

13.80 Spring branch, 1 lk. wide, course NE.

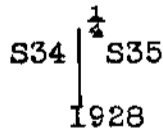
18.70 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course E.

A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.67*E., 54 lks. dist.

A fir, 22 ins. diam., bears N.38*W., 56 lks. dist.

Marked ¼ S 34 B T.
