CHAINS

Land, mountainous.  
 Soil, rocky loam; third rate.  
 Timber, fir, madrone, hemlock and alder.  
 Undergrowth, vine maple and rhododendron.

N.89\*50'E., on a random line bet. secs. 23 and 26.

- 40.00 Set temp.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.
- 79.96 Intersect the N. and S. line, 16 lks. N. of the cor. of sec. 23, 24, 25 and 26.  
 Thence,  
 S.89\*57'W., on a true line bet. secs. 23 and 26.  
 Descend 870 ft. over broken W. slope, through timber and brush.
- 3.30 Head of draw, course NW.
- 31.90 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course SW.  
 Ascend 100 ft. over SE. slope.
- 39.60 Spur, slopes S.
- 39.98 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. in diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap marked,  

$$\begin{array}{c} S23 \\ \frac{1}{4} \\ S26 \\ 1928 \end{array}$$

 from which  
     A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.5\*E., 25 lks. dist.  
     Marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 23 B T.  
     A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S.65\*E., 19 lks. dist.  
     Marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S 26 B T.  
 Descend 50 ft. over SW. slope.
- 41.80 Draw, course S.15\*E.  
 Ascend 204 ft. over SE. slope.
- 47.00 Spur, slopes S.15\*E.  
 Descend 114 ft. over SW. slope.
- 51.50 Draw, course S.10\*E.  
 Ascend 52 ft. over SE. slope.
- 55.30 Spur, slopes S.15\*E.
